## Organ Harvesting from live Falun Gong practitioners

China has emerged as a major power on the world stage, but while its economy has flourished, its people have been left behind. Today, China ranks among the worst nations in the world with regards to human rights and rule of law, raising important questions about how the United States and the international community should engage with this Asian giant.

Guest speakers include:

**Hon. David Kilgour, PC, BA, LL.B** was Canada's longest-serving parliamentarian and a former Liberal cabinet minister. In and out of office, Kilgour has earned a reputation as an ardent defender of international human rights, challenging the international community to act on the crisis in Darfur and, more recently, in China. In the summer of 2006, Mr. Kilgour and Mr. Matas co-authored an investigative report on allegations that the Chinese government is removing and selling the organs of Falun Gong prisoners of conscience.

**David Matas, LL.B**, one of Canada's most prominent international human rights and refugee lawyers, having served on the Canadian delegation United Nations General Assembly, the United Nations Conference on an International Criminal Court 1998, and the Stockholm International Forum on the Holocaust, among others. Since 1997 he has also served as Director of the International Centre for Human Rights & Democratic Development.

**Wenyi Wang, M.D., Ph.D** On April 20, Dr. Wang cried out at the ceremony for Chinese leader Hu Jintao on the South Lawn of the White House. Dr. Wang called out to Mr. Hu and President Bush to stop the organ harvesting from live Falun Gong practitioners in China's labor camps and end the seven-year persecution of Falun Gong.

**Charles Lee, M.D.** Dr. Charles Li, a U.S. citizen and Harvard-educated medical doctor, returned to China and attempted to publicize the persecution of Falun Gong to the Chinese people by tapping into China's state-controlled television. China's communist regime imprisoned him in a labor camp for 3 years. Repatriated in 2006, Charles is now letting the public know about his personal experiences. He suffered mental and physical torture, brainwashing, and forced-feedings, and was also forced to make products for export to the United States.
